### 1. Classroom Expectations

Every student earns 10 points daily for participation. Tardies, non-participation, excessive talking, inappropriate or disrespectful language, missing materials, cell phone or tablet use and doing work for other classes will result in loss of points.

Students are expected to be in the choir room at the report times listed below. **In the event of an emergency absence, students will have two school days to bring in a parent/guardian note before the grade automatically becomes a zero.
