- Students are expected to <u>attend all classes</u>, with the following exception:

- If your student is absent from a final exam block because they overslept, thought they didn't have to be there, etc. ~ their absence will be "Unexcused" & they will receive a "Zero".
- Teachers have communicated to students the expectation to attend classes!
- If your student needs to leave school early, please call (303) 646-4616 and leave a message the day before, if possible.
- We will not interrupt Final Exam Blocks to give students messages or passes to leave the building.
- Students are required to remain in their classroom, even if they finish the exam early.
- We encourage students to avoid absences during Finals Week.
- Attendance to Study Hall class is not required during the final exam block.
- Attendance to Learning Support is required, as directed by the teacher!
- If a student "plans" to be absent for one or more classes (out of town, medical procedure, etc.) during Final Week, parents must notify the Attendance Office ASAP regarding this planned absence, (303) 646-4616.
- All final exams must be completed by students no later than Friday, January 10, 2025, at 3:30 PM.
- Students must make an APPOINTMENT with teachers if taking a final between 1:10~3:20 PM during
 Finals Week!
- If the student needs to take a final early due to extenuating circumstances, the student/parent must discuss the issue with Mr. McClendon, who will determine if the student may take the exam early. He will then notify teachers to work with the student.

REGARDING ATTENDANCE DURING FINALS WEEK:
