Curriculum:

This year's students will be following the curriculum from *Prentice Hall Mathematics Common Core* and each student will receive their own book for this course.

Online Resources:

Due to COVID - 19 I will be building my classroom almost completely on Google Classroom. I will also be using IXL (practice math and resources), which will be linked through google classroom but will have a separate login.

Almost all homework assignments, quizzes, tests, will be submitted online. This allows the students to get immediate feedback on all class work and will allow the transition to a possibility of remote learning almost seamless.

Other resources:

If ever struggling on a subject, Khan Academy has great videos to re-explain sections. There will also be various resources available on google classroom.

Toolkit & Tests:

Each section a student will fill out and put all of their notes in a given toolkit, these will have all the vocabulary for each section and will be split into sections for each subject. This is essentially their notes, and they will be allowed to use this and only this on tests (there will be additional copies on google classroom that may be printed off if lost). The toolkit used during the test must be in that student's handwriting so that way there is no plagiarism going on. If there is any suspicion of cheating the student(s) will be given a zero.

What each assignment is worth:

- Warm-ups: 10 points each
- Quizzes: 20 points each
- Homework: 30 points each (completion grade)
- Tests: 50 points each
- Goal Sheet: 50 points

Late Policy:

Students are required to turn assignments in on time for full credit. Late assignments are accepted through the next week after the due date for 75% of grade earned on assignments, and then after that 50% of grade earned.

I want to encourage students to do the work even if it is for the 50% of earned grade, some credit is better than no credit.

Absent: All assignments missed while absent will be on google classroom if it was an online assignment, and there will also be a hard copy in the absent work bin if it was something we did on paper and not online; Following the make-up work policy in the planner.
