7th Grade Elective Class Options

2D Art 7

Explore techniques, materials, and concepts used in two dimensional drawing, painting, and collage. Perfect your technique and strengthen your designs. Have fun and express yourself while developing your 2D art skills!

3D Design 7

Create works of art in clay, paper mache, cardboard, and other three-dimensional media. You will learn about sculpture, while working individually and collaboratively. Come build outside the box!

Band 7

Prerequisite: Beginning Band or teacher approval

Expand your skills on your instrument. Now that you've got the hang of the basics, get into the deeper stuff with more advanced music, concepts, and impressive techniques. Evening performances required. ***Year Long Class

Orchestra 7

Prerequisite: Beginning Orchestra or teacher approval

Expand your knowledge and abilities in this group of dedicated musicians. Students will be challenged with a higher level of music and develop further skills in orchestral playing. Evening performances required. ***Year Long Class

Choir 7

Expand your choral singing abilities. This class will focus on more challenging harmonies and different languages! Evening performances required. Students may take choir for either one semester or a full year!

Drama 7

Learn how to do a jaw-dropping audition, learn great warm up activities to prepare for performance, work together with others to perform skits and adapt your own stories for the stage.

Computer Innovations

Follow the problem-solving process and identify real-world problems, then design apps to help solve those problems. Collect, analyze, visualize, and make computer automated decisions using data. Explore the relationship between hardware and software while building interactive projects.

Robotics

Are you interested in seeing what makes a robot tick? Would you like to create your own "helper" robot? This class explores the world of robotics through programming manipulation, proper wiring and woodshop framework to make a complete robot.

Engineering

Would you like to build a catapult and test it? Can you make a tower 3 feet tall and have it hold a person? If so then this class needs you! This class will explore deeper into the engineering world. The use of all the machines will be available throughout the class as you compete against your fellow peers to make the best structures possible!

Sports & Games 7

Sports & Games is a semester long physical education class that will focus on a variety of traditional sports and large group games. Sports may include basketball, volleyball, soccer, flag football, softball, wiffle ball, and some aspects of track & field. Games may include team handball, speed-a-way, ultimate frisbee, wiffle ball, capture the flag and combatives. Emphasis is placed on participation, teamwork, game rules, strategies, sportsmanship and fair play. This is a new and exciting opportunity for EMS students that love to participate in sports and games as a means to improving their overall health and fitness.
