Preschool Tuition Assistance

Colorado Preschool Program (CPP)

The Colorado Preschool Program Intake Form and Economic Data Survey Form are used to identify students who may qualify for CPP funding. The CPP form is in the registration packet and the Economic Data Survey form is provided to families when it becomes available. These forms need to be completed and returned to be considered for CPP assistance. A team from the Elbert County Early Childhood Council discusses eligible students and determines who will receive funding. The district receives an allotted number of CPP 'slots' each year and is often unable to accommodate all families who apply. Qualifying students are rank ordered based on eligibility factors. The majority of families chosen to receive funding will be notified in August. Other families will be notified as slots become available.
