## **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

Pursuant to District Policy DN, the Board of Education for the Elizabeth School District has the authority to dispose of any District property not needed in the foreseeable future. The rock referenced above is being recommended for disposal because it is not needed and no longer provides a useful benefit to the district. Some of the rock has been used by the district for landscaping purposes, but there is little use for it going forward and staff would like to allow district employees the opportunity to make use of for their personal landscaping projects. The district will have plenty of more rock next year when the roof at Elizabeth High School is replaced.
