RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the revisions to the Elizabeth School District, Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget as presented.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

The purpose of this revision is to account for the purchase of the school busses, the financing of the vehicles, and the purchase of the HVAC control software. Additionally, as of March we will have exceeded the anticipated Improvement Fee revenue, so that line item has also been increased to pay for the HVAC control software.

These revisions are only affecting the General Fund Budget and that is why only the General Fund pages are included in the packet. However, with these modifications the Appropriation Resolution will need to be changed to reflect the revisions, along with the Fund Balance Resolution, which will reflect the prior approvals of the remaining funds in both resolutions.

FISCAL IMPACT:

With the current budget as presented, it is anticipated that the District's General Fund will end the current fiscal year with a fund balance of \$2,444,178. As a percentage of expenditures and transfers, the projected ending fund balance is 11.49%.
