7.0 COMMUNICATIONS

7.1 DAC Parent Survey Results

Last spring parents were asked to complete a short online survey implemented by the District Accountability Committee (DAC). Susanna Jordan, DAC Chair, presented the results to the board. Susanna indicated that the survey focused on questions related to Communications, Technology, and Safety. There were 470 responses, a slight increase from the previous year. Overall the responses were positive. Some specifics include 90% of the responders agreed they felt their child was safe at school, over 80% agreed the communication from the school is effective, over 80% agreed the teachers set high expectations for learning. The responders to the survey identified Teacher Retention, Improvement of Technology, and Improvement of Facilities as the three greatest needs of the district.

7.2 Chief Financial Officer Report

Chief Finance Director Ron Patera gave the financial report. General fund revenues collected are at 99,90% through the end of June, while General fund expenses are at 94.33% spent however these statements are prepared on the cash basis of accounting. Several improvements were made to our facilities District wide. Some of the projects include a new fire alarm system at Running Creek Elementary, enhanced cell reception at Singing Hills Elementary, landscaping, deep cleaning, painting, repairing and preparation at all schools.

7.3 HR Update

Kin Shuman Director of Human Resources gave a hiring update. The District hired 28 new teachers for the school year. The group of teachers is a balance of first time teachers and experienced teachers, some from Colorado and some from across the country. We also hired five new counselors and several new hires to the Special Services Team. New teacher orientation was held the morning of August 10. We also have new members among our support staff, classified, and administrative staff. The Transportation Department is fully staffed with bus drivers and with substitute bus drivers. The new pay scale for bus drivers made a difference in this hiring effort. This is the first time in several years that the Transportation Department is able to start the school year with a full staff of bus drivers.

7.4 Technology Update

Marty Silva Director of Technology gave an update on the summer projects the Technology Team implemented District wide. A new online registration system is now in place. This reduces the parent paperwork and redundancy of information especially for families with multiple students. The school buildings are able to process the data entries and registration information in a timelier manner. A new phone system was implemented throughout the District. In an effort to improve the safety of students and staff, phones will be in all classrooms. If there is an emergency in the classroom teachers may now place the emergency call directly from their classroom. Parents will have the ability to call teachers directly, outside of classroom hours, or leave a voicemail directly for the teacher during class time. SchoolMessenger is the new system that will be used District wide for voice and email communication and emergency notifications.

7.5 Superintendent Report

During the Superintendent Report, Douglas Bissonette spoke on the requirement that all employees take the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) Training and the Incident Command System (ICS 100) Training. On August 7 over 25 employees participated in the SRP and ICS 100 training instructed by Safe Schools Chair Rob McMullen, Elizabeth Fire Marshall Kara Gerczynsk and Fire Chief TJ Steck. Douglas Bissonette highlighted the work of Marianne Hughes, senior at EHS, who is leading a collaborative effort to elevate student voice throughout the district. Marianne was one of three student leaders from our District that participated in the Student Leadership Workshop at the Colorado Association of School Boards annual convention in 2014. The Cardinal Clay Challenge and the 5K Run the Parks scheduled for August 15 help to support Elizabeth High School. The Elizabeth High School will be hosting the Elizabeth Networking Group (ENG) Back to School Event on September 24 from 6:00-8:00pm. There will be vendors, tours of the schools, entertainment, and refreshments. This event is open to the community

Chris Richardson also commented on Marianne Hughes who was one of two students from Colorado selected to participate in Girls Nation, a program providing aspiring young women leaders' firsthand experience with practical insight into how the federal government works.
