Advisory Time Changes From All Study Halls To Intervention And Exploratory Time

- 6th grade is implementing Tier II math, reading, writing intervention time in Advisory (M-Th)
- 7th grade is looking at math data and targeting students who struggle with computation. The math lab is during Advisory (M-Th) to help build skills.
- 7/8 Team is piloting a program during their core time called Study Island which targets their low-end readers.
- 8th grade has implemented a weekly afterschool Study Lab.
- 7th grade has implemented and is piloting a homework accountability program called WIN. It stands for Work in Now. Students who do not complete a homework assignment during the day report to the WIN classroom during Advisory (M-Th) to complete the assignment on that day.

7th grade Team Pilot

What Is WIN?....

- When a student doesn't complete a homework assignment, they are assigned WIN that day during Advisory.
- During WIN they complete their homework for full credit.

Findings from first quarter of pilot:

- First Quarter
 - 6 students had a single F in a single core class
 - 6 students had multiple F's in a core class
 - Total Fs = 18
- Second Quarter
 - 3 students had a single F in a single core class

Next Steps:

- Continue conversation on meaningful homework.
- Continue to weed out those students who won't do it from those who cannot do it and add support.
- > Train peer tutors to work with students in need.
