Frontier High School Graduation Plan 2020

Frontier High School is requesting to be able to have an outside graduation on May 29, 2020 at 10:00 AM. We propose the following:

- 1. 15-20 graduates will find their seats outside on the West Field. Seats will be at least 6 feet apart. They may be dropped off on the North side of Field and walk across the "playground" area to access the field.
- 2. The Graduates will already be dressed in their caps and gowns. No Student or Parents will be allowed inside the high school or on the field. Faculty, of which there are a total of 10, including office staff and custodians, may access the building if needed. But will not congregate as a whole group.
- 3. All graduates and faculty will wear masks furnished by the school. Except when being photographed by a professional photographer or speaking at the podium.
- 4. Faculty will act as stewards, for drop off, seating and exiting. They will then take a seat on the field with proper social distancing.
- 5. Parents will be allowed to view the ceremony from their private vehicles parked along Dale Court.
- 6. During the ceremony each student will be announced and called to the podium to deliver a short senior speech. The podium will be wiped down between speakers and a New Microphone cover will be applied between students.
- 7. After giving their speech each student will pick up their Diploma from a table near the podium. These will be labeled and separated to allow this without requiring contact of anyone elses Diploma. Students would then return to their seat.
- 8. Following the Ceremony students will exit the field via the back side parking lot and will be picked up by their parents. Staff will direct vehicles and students to maintain social distancing and one car at a time picking up their student.
- 9. A professional photographer will be on hand during the ceremony and after to take photos. The family may drive to the Front (East) of the building for a photo but must agree to one family at a time.
- 10. The graduation ceremony should last approximately 60 minutes.
- 11. Students and parents must sign a form indicating they understand the potential risk of participating in this gathering.
- 12. The Elizabeth Police Department will be asked to assist with traffic and secure the grounds once the ceremony is underway.
