The process has been to support the schools in the process of building the school level UIP.	
					The schools will take ownership of their UIP's. These documents are evolving. Superintendent Bissonette or Director Duran will be happy to sit down and go through more thoroughly if the board would like. Superintendent Bissonette reviewed Running Creek Elementary UIP. He pointed out on page 4 is where staff starts to put information into the plan, such as achievement, growth, growth gaps, and post secondary readiness. The narrative is where the staff will put what has been done, what trends they see, and what did they look at. Root Cause Analysis could be developed over the course of the year. Key personnel – Instructional Coaches and Principals work with staff to complete the school level UIP. The structure of a work session with the board would work well to cover all the schools UIP's to allow the time needed to review all information in	
					and the schools UTP's to allow the time needed to review all information in each plan. Superintendent Bissonette said the District UTP will be a little more top down this year. He would like to see the district be accredited with distinction. To accomplish this, Superintendent Bissonette looked at other districts with that accreditation to see what they are doing and found it very clear our students were not performing at other districts level. Items he found other district are reporting, first, their students are reading higher at the elementary level; second their academic growth gaps are smaller at the middle levels; third, their higher math achievement at the high school level. Superintendent Bissonette will distribute the school and district UTP to DAC at their next meeting on March 14 th . They will have a month to review the documents.	
					11.3 SB 191 Educator Effectiveness Superintendent Bissonette presented information on SB 191. He has assembled a committee made up of teachers from each building, Director Lanphere, and Director Duran. The committee will use the state format – Teacher Quality Standards. The committee with look at each of the standards one at a time. There are two parts to each standard– growth data – teacher/principal quality.
