Collected 67.84% of revenues. Impending transactions include: Salary Accruals - \$130,000 and BOCES payments - \$220,000. Checks over \$5,000 list is small. One out of ordinary expense is for the cost of a rebuilt engine for a bus. The board would like to see the Wells Fargo expenditures broken out in each of the reports.		
						Reduction in student enrollment is approximately 60 students for the 2012-13 school year. The district will need to have \$500,000 in the Self Insurance fund. PERA increase is about \$90,000 and of that is \$50,000 for later years. District staff is developing a financially responsible plan that puts students at the heart of everything we do.
