7th 2D Art

7th 3D Design

Learn new techniques of three-dimensional art, strengthen your creativity, and increase your knowledge of art and artists (of many different times, places, and styles). Create 3D works of art, utilizing a variety of media, such as ceramics, paper mache, found objects, and more.

7th Band Beginning/Intermediate/Advanced ****Year- Long Class****

Come learn to play a band instrument. Band instruments include all woodwinds, brass, and percussion. Pick an instrument to play, learn the basics and play with some amazing people! No experience required!! Just the love music and an interest in music. Two after school concerts a semester are required. ***(Students can be placed in Intermediate or Advanced Band upon teacher recommendation).***

7th Orchestra Beginning/Intermediate/Advanced ****Year-Long Class****

Come and learn an orchestra instrument. Orchestra instruments are violin, viol, cello, and double bass. Pick an instrument to play, learn the basics and play with your classmates! No experience required!! Just the love for music and an interest in playing an instrument. Two after school concerts a semester are required. ***(Students can be placed in Intermediate or Advanced Orchestra upon teacher recommendation).***

7th Choir

Expand your choral singing abilities. This class will focus on more challenging harmonies and different languages! Evening performances required.

7th Advanced Choir ****Year-Long Class (teacher approval and initial, and one semester previous choir class required)****

This year-long choir class will focus on building high level skills through more challenging music.

7th Theatre

Learn how to do a jaw-dropping audition, learn great warm up activities to prepare for performance, work together with others to perform skits, and adapt your own stories for the stage.

7th Technology Innovations

In this class, students will follow the problem-solving process and identify real-world problems. They will then design apps to help solve these problems. Students will also collect, analyze, make computer automated decisions using data, and explore the ever changing world of AI.

7th Yearbook *****Year long class*** (teacher approval and initial required)*****

Is photography, journalism, and design your thing? Be a part of capturing every one's middle school memories and help create, market, and distribute the school year book.

7th Engineering

Would you like to build a catapult and test it? Can you make a glider fly across the field? If so, this class needs you! This class will explore deeper into the engineering world. The band saw, drill press, lathe, jointer and planar will be available throughout the course as you compete against your peers to make the best structures possible!

7th Robotics

Do you want to make a robot? This class explores the world of robotics through programming manipulation, proper wiring, and woodworking techniques. Your final project will include art, programming, robotics, and woodworking elements.

7th Advanced PE **(***teacher approval and initial required***)**

Advanced PE will promote individual participation in daily strength and conditioning activities to help maintain/increase personal physical fitness. The goal of the course is to increase muscular strength, power, agility, and endurance. This course is designed for 7th and 8th Grade students who are seriously looking to increase their overall fitness to a higher level over the 9 week quarter.
