

Elizabeth High School Implements Text-A-Tip

Text-A-Tip will offer high school students a new way to communicate safety concerns. The program utilizes the same technology as Crime Stoppers but allows Elizabeth High School students to send a text message in real time. Students are able to report criminal events in progress, such as a fight or an assault, or give information about a crime or express concern over a student who may be in trouble or suicidal. The tips are monitored 24 hours a day, and if the tip involves a crime in progress, it will be sent to the appropriate police dispatch center for immediate response.
