

## **Every Step Every Day**

Every step is taken every day, to the best of our ability, to make sure your children and our staff are safe at school.

- School safety drills include fire, lockdown and tornado. The Elizabeth Fire Department and Sheriff's Office are actively involved in our safety drills.
- Scheduled supervision at entrances before/after school and elementary cross walks
- Schools conduct walk-arounds, checking doors to make sure they are locked, checking facilities, and checking playground equipment
- No Show Process - when students do not show up to school and we have not received a phone call explaining the absence, schools will call the parents to confirm location of the student.
- Sign in process at all schools for all visitors on campus
- Cameras in hallways and entryways
- Weather alert systems installed in all schools and all principals are signed up for Code Red Alert
- District-wide training for all employees on ICS 100 (Incident Command System) based on the FEMA standards (Federal Emergency Management Agency)
- Incident Command Chart is outlined for each school.
- Talking to our students about school safety and schools as a safe environment is an ongoing practice
